



Bachelor Degree Audit Sheet General Education Requirements for the Bachelor Degree Program

I. Skills (12-15 Credits)

- ENG 101 (ENGS 095 for SEEK Students only)
 - ENG 201
 - SPE 113 (SPES 093 for SEEK Students only)
 - MAT 104 OR MAT 105
 - MAT 108 OR MAT 141 (MAT 141, pre-calculus is required for CIS, ECO, FOS and some FIS majors)
- (Math placement is dependent upon your CUNY Assessment Test Mathematics score)**

II. Core Requirements (15 Credits)

ENG 101 is a prerequisite for all 200 level courses

(HIS 231 and HIS 232 will be replaced by the following courses starting in the FALL of 2009)

- HIS 203 *
- HIS 204 *
- HIS 205 *

*(BA and BS students must complete any two of these courses in sequential order)

- PHI 231

ENG 201 is a prerequisite for all LIT courses

- LIT 230 or 231
- LIT 232 or 233

III. Distribution Requirements

Cultural Studies (6-12 Credits)

- Foreign Language* (students are required to complete 2 semesters of the same foreign language)
- ETH 123, 124, or 125
- Fine Arts: Any Art, Music, or Drama course

* NYS Students who have completed 3 years of a language at the high school level and received a grade of 75 or higher on a Level III Regents Examination are exempt from the foreign language requirement.

Social Sciences (6 Credits)

Two courses are required from this section:

(Check Major Prerequisites)

- ANT 101
- ECO 101
- GOV 101
- PSY 101
- SOC 101

Sciences (4-8 Credits)

- NSC 107*

*NYS Students who have completed 3 years of science in high school and received a grade of 75 or higher on 2 science regents are exempt from the Natural Science 107 requirement.

- ENV 108, FOS 108, or PHY 108

All students must take an additional science course after completing or being exempt from Natural Science 107.

Physical Education (1-3 Credits)

- Any PED Course*

* An exemption can be granted to students that participate in a John Jay College athletics team or have police, fire fighter or military training.
